1. **PUBLIC** - Mrs. Weston asked if there had been any further developments from B.V.T. and requested an assurance from the Council that it would keep on top of this matter.

Six members of the public who were residents of St. Lukes road Doseley, had attended the meeting to present concerns over a dramatic increase in the levels of traffic using Doseley Road following the implementation of traffic calming measures on Finger Road, Dawley.  
The problems encountered by residents were discussed by the meeting.

Sgt Franks gave details of co-operation between Pc Micky Riggs (Traffic Manager, Police) and Anurada Fitzwalter of T&WC in such matters and members agreed to invite the two to a future meeting of the council.
