**PUBLIC SESSION**

No public session was held, there being no members of the public present.

**04/36 APOLOGIES**

Apologies along with the reason for absence were received and accepted from Cllr. Pritchard.

**04/37 Minutes of the meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2004**

The **Minutes of the meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2004** were approved as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

**04/38 Traffic Calming Frame Lane**

The Clerk confirmed that he had telephoned Mr. Roderick over the long awaited publication of the weight limit order and had been (yet again) promised that the order would be published. The Clerk was asked to write formally to Mr. Roderick and copy the correspondence to Cllr. Davis, leader of the Borough Council.

**04/39 Clerk's Report on Items Pending**

The Clerk reported that the work schedule for installation of bus shelter at Holly Road was under way, the shelter had been ordered and the contractors had promised a six week completion.

Cllr. Chetwood gave the meeting details of the completion schedule for the Youth Shelter.

**04/40 Village Improvements**

a) Grounds maintenance

No matters of general grounds maintenance were raised.

Members discussed the possibility of providing a lych gate at the entrance to

the war memorial site. The Clerk was asked to investigate costs.

Cllr. Hickie reported concerns over dislodged sand stone blocks under the Aqueduct – it was considered to be creating safety issues. Cllr. Hickie gave full details as to how the stones came to be dislodged. The Clerk was asked to contact Cllr. Davis pointing out the safety concerns and asking the Borough to take action.

Cllr. Haire informed the meeting that there had been some (all be it ineffective) police activity on the Silkin Way.

Cllr. Chetwood brought to the attention of the meeting, possible future plans to create a one way traffic system in roads approaching the Phoenix School. Although this area is outside the parish, it was thought that there would be implications for DHPC parishioners. Members expressed support for such a scheme in principle but reserved full comment until proper plans had been seen. The Clerk was asked to write to the head of the school to offer support in principle for such a scheme.

#### **04/44 Countryside Officers Report**

Cllr. Hickie reported that there were a number of trees within the parish that were down but they had been mostly attended to by the Borough.

#### **04/45 Other Items of Information**

Members discussed possible recipients of the Annual Parish Award to be presented at the Annual Parish Meeting.

Cllr. Onions informed the meeting that it had now been confirmed that the Methodist Church on Holly Road Little Dawley would close mid year. The Clerk was asked to write to the Church thanking them for hosting the

Armistice Day Service and wishing members of the congregation well.
