09/69 Minutes

09/72 Traffic Calming – Majestic Way Aqueduct

The meeting discussed notification by the Borough that due to non-compliance with current regulations T&WC were proposing to remove the raised tables and re-profile the existing footway on Majestic Way. Concern was raised as to why the raised tables did not meet the current regulations – otherwise the meeting had no objections to the proposals.

The meeting received the completed footpath leaflets, entitled "A Walk Through Aqueduct History", which had been designed by the Aqueduct Historical Society on behalf of the Parish Council.
