

**DAWLEY HAMLETS PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of a meeting of the above committee held on Monday 4th July 2005
at Horsehay Village Hall at 7.15 p.m.

PUBLIC SESSION

Mr. Taylor had attended to ask Council for their support for a proposal for the provision of a footpath at Aqueduct. The Chairman explained to Mr. Taylor that his scheme had been put to Council at its previous full meeting and it had been resolved to take no action. This, he explained, would not prevent Mr. Taylor from putting forward his proposals to the Borough and the Parish would not object; it simply meant that the Parish would not promote the scheme. Mr. Taylor was content and stated that he would present his proposal to the Borough.

7.32 p.m. Mr. Taylor left the meeting.

The Chairman introduced Mr. James and Mr. Brown to the meeting. The Borough Officers had attended at the request of Council to discuss Youth Provision in the Parish (13 to 19 years old). Following discussion Mr. James recommended that the Parish undertake a pilot period of research undertaken by detached youth workers to ascertain the needs of the parish youth. A report would be prepared and recommendations made. Members agreed in principle to support the commissioning of a survey providing the cost was reasonable. Mr. James was asked to provide an estimate of the costs for the main meeting to approve.
