a) General Grounds Maintenance

b) Maintenance of War memorial Cross

It was agreed that quotes should be obtained locally.

The Clerk reported that he had explored the matter of securing the wreaths on the War Memorial with the handyman and it was felt that a suitable solution could be found.

Cllr. Chetwood reported that local craftsmen had promised to look at the cross to give a quote for replacement.

Cllr. Beryl Onions informed the meeting that there had ben a report in the Shropshire Star indicating that the PCC had received permission to close the burial ground at Doseley.
