05/053 APOLOGIES

| W05/0423 | Erection of UPVC and brick conservatory to rear 17 Myford Horsehay. There were no objections. |
| W05/0403 | Certificate of lawfulness for the storage of plant and motor vehicles and erection of security fencing Redroofs Deepfield. Members expressed concern over this application due to poor access (over a byway open to all traffic which was not a made up metalled road), noise and air pollution. In addition, Council felt that the development was not in keeping with the surrounding area which was open amenity space. |
| W05/0432 | Erection of detached dwelling and garage Land adjacent to 15 Spring Village Horsehay. There were no objections. Members asked that the materials be kept in line with those of the area. |

Bus Shelters

The Clerk reported that he had spoken to a new contractor who had agreed to quote for the building of a bus shelter.

a) Grounds maintenance
