07/86 Minutes

07/88 Planning Applications

The following applications were received:

W08/0545 Single storey extension to the front of existing dwelling Apple Cottage 31 Holly Road Little Dawley. There were no objections.

W08/0435 Erection of a single storey side/rear extension 19 Lawford Close Aqueduct. There were no objections.

W08/0469 Construction of two storey three bedroom detached dwelling house and reduction of wall height and alteration to levels of land to rear of the site Land adjoining Deepfield Lodge Holly Road Little Dawley. There were no objections.
