Mr. Gwilliam brought to Council his concern that the Borough Council had publicised their scheme for purging the Woodside estate of abandoned and scrap vehicles. He was concerned that they had chosen to bring all of the vehicles through Little Dawley to the site of Telford Motor Spares. Although Members felt that the use of TMS would most likely be a commercial decision by the Borough it was agreed that they could be asked for their reasons.

Mr. Gwilliam also asked Council if something could be done to encourage the shop keepers of Little Dawley to keep their patch free of litter – the area was looking increasingly neglected.
