**PUBLIC SESSION**

There were no members of the public present.

**03/83 APOLOGIES**

Apologies along with reasons for absence were forwarded by Cllr. Mrs. D. Wallis, Cllr. D. Gibson and Cllr. R. Haire. The apologies were accepted.

**03/84 STROWP**

The Meeting received written reports from STROWP.

**03/85 Minutes of the meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2003**

The **Minutes of the meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2003** were approved as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

**03/86 Traffic Calming Frame Lane**

Members heard that the work was partly completed but had been placed on hold whilst the remainder of the road is subject to work by the utilities. The Clerk reported that Mr. Roderick had confirmed that the weight limit order would be made shortly.

**03/87 Lightmoor Development**

Members agreed that a representative of The Bournville Trust should be invited to attend an informal meeting with Council. The Clerk was asked to invite Mr. Alan Shrimpton of Bournville.

**03/88 Items Pending**

The Clerk reported he had during the previous month held site meetings with Kevin Price to discuss the provision of a bus shelter and Mark Greaves resolve the outstanding matters relating to the damaged bollards outside the Foresters

Arms and the broken fencing and dumping of garden waste at Aqueduct Village. Mr. Price had agreed to formally investigate the use of buses on the route and feasibility of placing a shelter on the proposed site. Mr. Greaves had agreed to replace the bollards and follow up on the other matters reported.

#### **a) Grounds maintenance within the parish**

The Clerk reported that he had instructed Mr. Cowley, the handyman, to tidy up the war memorial site in readiness for Remembrance Sunday.

Cllr. Chetwood asked the meeting to consider youth provisions within the parish. Members discussed the possibilities of funding. The Clerk was asked to invite a Youth Officer from the Borough to speak to the Parish Council.

The Clerk reported that he had spoken to the contractor. The position remained that although it was difficult to get the contractor on site, the work was still on the table and experience had shown that it was extremely difficult to get any other contractor to quote for the work.

**03/93 Countryside Officers Report**

**There was no report.**

**03/94 Other Items of Information**

Cllr. Onions reported that some 16 years or so ago an accident involving a vehicle, knocked over a lamp post in Woodhouse Lane. The lamp had never been replaced. Residents had now requested that it be replaced. The Clerk was asked to contact the Borough to pass on the request.

Members discussed the proposed closure of the accident and emergency department at the Princess Royal Hospital. The Clerk was asked to invite Mr. Phil Homer of the Trust to address the Council on the topic and then place the matter on the main agenda.

Cllr. Hickie reported that the newly placed post box at the end of Malory Drive had not found favour in its positioning with the residents. A request was made that the box be moved some 20 or 30 yards adjacent to an existing lay-by. The Chairman reminded the meeting that a planning application had been presented to this Council and considered at a meeting. No difficulties were raised at that time. The Clerk was asked to write to the Post Master to ascertain if the box could be moved.

Cllr. Chetwood received an invitation to attend the unveiling of the war memorial plaque on the Aqueduct at 2.30 p.m. on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> November.

Members were reminded that a Remembrance Day service was to be held at 10.30 a.m. at Little Dawley Methodist Church.

Cllr. Chetwood displayed to the meeting an old Ordinance Survey map of the area (Dawley Urban District Council) prior to the major changes which have taken place since the creation of Telford New Town. He felt that it would be informative if a copy of the old map could be made and an acetate of a new map placed over the top so that residents could clearly see the many changes which had taken place over the years. Members agreed to undertake the project and the Clerk was asked to investigate the work.

Members agreed that future meetings of the Committee should be held at 7.15 p.m.
