08/40 APOLOGIES

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr. A. Hickie.

08/41 Minutes

The **Minutes of the meeting held on 6th October 2008** were approved as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

Cllr. Mrs Onions reported that the bollards at the top of Foresters Close had been repaired.

08/42 Public Session

There were no members of the public in attendance.

08/43 Planning Applications

The following applications were received:

W08/1179 Erection of single storey front extension 3 Simpson's Walk
Horsehay. There were no objections.

W08/1125 Erection of a single storey extension to side 4 Rednall Fields Little
Dawley. There were no objections.

W08/1137 Extension and alteration to form enlarged doctors surgery with
additional dental practice Trinity Healthcare Centre Majestic Way
Aqueduct.

The following permissions were received:

W08/0999 Erection of two detached four bedroomed dwellings with garages
and conservatories land adjacent to 8 Spring Cottage
Rednall Fields Little Dawley.

W08/1078 Erection of two detached two storey dwellings following
demolition of existing bungalow The Bungalow Rednall Fields
Little Dawley. The meeting expressed concerns over access and
egress to this site along with the associated traffic problems.

The following refusal was received:

W08/0290 Erection of two bedroom detached dormer bungalow Land adjacent to Manuka Croft Lightmoor.

08/44 Village Greens

The meeting discussed a request by a resident to protect an area of land known as Aqueduct Green by making it a village green. It was agreed to refer the request to the Borough Council with support from the parish.

08/45 Village Improvements

The meeting was made aware of an application before the Borough Council for an off licence to be granted to Majestic way Stores. Although the PC was no longer a statutory consultee, it felt obliged to consider the impact of the proposed licence on the community as the application was brought to its attention by residents who objected. Council considered the merits of a licence for the area and resolved to object to granting of a licence on the grounds of concerns over possible anti social behaviour.

a) General Grounds Maintenance

The Clerk reported that the handyman had cut back overgrown bushes in Little Dawley and attended to the gravel deposits washed onto Lightmoor Road.

b) The Aqueduct maintenance and upkeep

Cllr. Haire reported that graffiti on the aqueduct had been attended to by volunteers. The Clerk confirmed that he had not received a response from the Borough surveyor.

c) Holy Well

Cllr. Mrs Onions volunteered to ask the Methodist minister for information and help in regard to the Holy Well.
