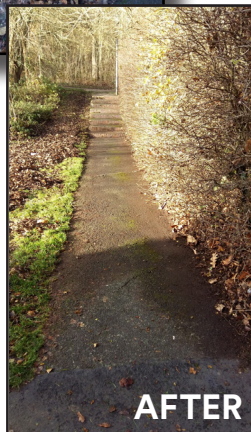
Horsehay Pool/Old Bridge Road Development Scheme
