OLD ROADWAY BETWEEN BRIDGE ROAD & THE TRAVELLERS JOY PUBLIC HOUSE

Several local residents have asked about progress with the reinstatement of the historic roadway alongside the old Horsehay Works. Telford & Wrekin Council submitted a Definitive Map Modification Order (DMMO) in 2018 and the Parish Council expects this to result in a Public Inquiry this year, hopefully in the Summer.

The Public Inquiry will look at all the evidence for and against establishing a Public Right of Way and if it is successful it is hoped that the roadway will be reopened as a route for local residents.

Many residents have already submitted evidence statements of their previous use of the route and these will support the case for its reinstatement.

If you have used this route in the past it is still possible to submit a statement. Please contact the Senior Rights of Way Officer, Andrew Careless, at Telford & Wrekin Council, PO Box 457, Wellington Civic Offices Telford, TF2 2FH or the Parish Clerk for further information.
