AN UPDATE FROM THE TELFORD STEAM RAILWAY, HORSEHAY

With an ambitious programme of events, the railway has attracted large numbers of visitors this summer. It all started at Easter with an entertaining day featuring 'Alice's Adventures to Wonderland.' Other events have included a Coronation Special, a Princesses Day, Fish and Chip Specials with food purchased from the Codfather, a Vintage Day including a triple fly-past by a Lancaster bomber and a Model Railway Day with Horsehay Village Hall being used for the railway layouts.

Meadowdale Garden Centre in Horsehay kindly donated plants, compost and bark, so we could develop one of the flower beds at Spring Village Station.

We have launched an appeal to restore the narrow-gauge tram that we operate around the yard at Spring Village. The steam tram, was initially operated on a short track in the Telford Town Park in the TDC days before being moved to the Telford Steam Railway.

Drainage work that was carried out from Horsehay and Dawley Station to the footpath crossing from Pool Hill Road has been completed, laying new track should start soon.

FRIENDS OF HORSEHAY POOL AND ENVIRONS LATEST NEWS

We are pleased to say that some further improvements to the Pool are under way. We have worked with Telford and Wrekin Council and some long awaited and much needed reeds are due to be planted at the North end of the Pool around the top edge of the island this Autumn. This will have a significant impact on improving the habitation for wildlife. The inlet around the island will also be re-dredged so that the water level around it should be maintained all year round. TWC have installed new safety signage at the Pool entrance and we have requested that all existing rusty signage is removed.

We are very grateful to DHPC for a grant towards pool improvements and to Cllrs Raj Mehta and Ian Preece for their Pride Fund support.

We have been busy bolstering our own fundraising by selling refreshments at Telford Steam Railway Model Railway Exhibition last month.

On the 3rd September we hosted a fantastic Scarecrow Festival with 20 scarecrows positioned around the Pool, including Donald Trump and Barbie, it was a glorious day and everyone enjoyed the event around our beautiful Pool. FROM THE FRIENDS OF DAWLEY HAMLETS LOCAL NATURE RESERVE (LNR)

Dawley Hamlets Local Nature Reserve has had a very successful Summer and Autumn with lots of nature spots across our 38-hectare site; a Cormorant, Kingfishers, Little Grebes, grass snakes, slow worms, common lizards, newts and lots of types of bees, dragonflies, butterflies and crickets. Don't forget our site covers from Parish Mount, Top Yard Mount right through and down to the Little Dawley Pools and Furnace Pools - why not have a walk around this Autumn and Winter to see what nature spots you can see? You can also see some of the fantastic work done by both Bug Life and Smallwoods/Energize with the cut back work they have been doing. One fantastic project this Summer has been the installation of new perch benches by The Sump and on Top Yard Mound which were made and fitted by Smallwoods and funded by DHPC. On the horizon, we are due to have new throw lines fitted and improved signage across the LNR.

Successful events last season included a pond-dipping event and our Summer event 'The Royal Adventures in Nature'. We were also delighted to welcome Shropshire Wildlife Trust to the site to complete activities with the children over the Summer holidays, Smallwoods to complete a Bat walk and several events from Bug Life such as identification and seed harvesting. Next up will be our popular Winter event

where you can see the LNR receive a magical makeover with fairy houses and lights; keep an eye on our Facebook page and posters in the LNR for details.
