



## Doseley and Horsehay Area Traffic Calming Public Consultation

### Background

Following concerns raised by residents, parish council and ward members, Telford and Wrekin Council are proposing to implement traffic calming measures on various roads in Horsehay and Doseley, following an initial consultation on a 20mph zone.

Various options have been considered from ideas that have been previously requested. Due to many of those being difficult or unfeasible to deliver, the following proposals are considered to offer the best overall solution to the problems being experienced in relation to speed and volume of traffic.

### Proposals

As part of our initial consultation on a 20mph zone we are proposing the following:

- Phased delivery of table-top style road humps (see plans within);
- Expanded 20mph zone to cover additional areas raised in the initial consultation.

The phased delivery of the road humps is to take in to account further planned developments and will be installed following completion of those works.

Humps marked A and B on the plan can be delivered almost immediately should a favourable response be received.

Humps marked C and D on the plan can only be

delivered following the completion of other housing development works.

### Have your say

Prior to implementing this scheme, we are seeking public views on the proposals.

All comments, representations and objections will be considered prior to making a final decision on whether the scheme will be implemented.

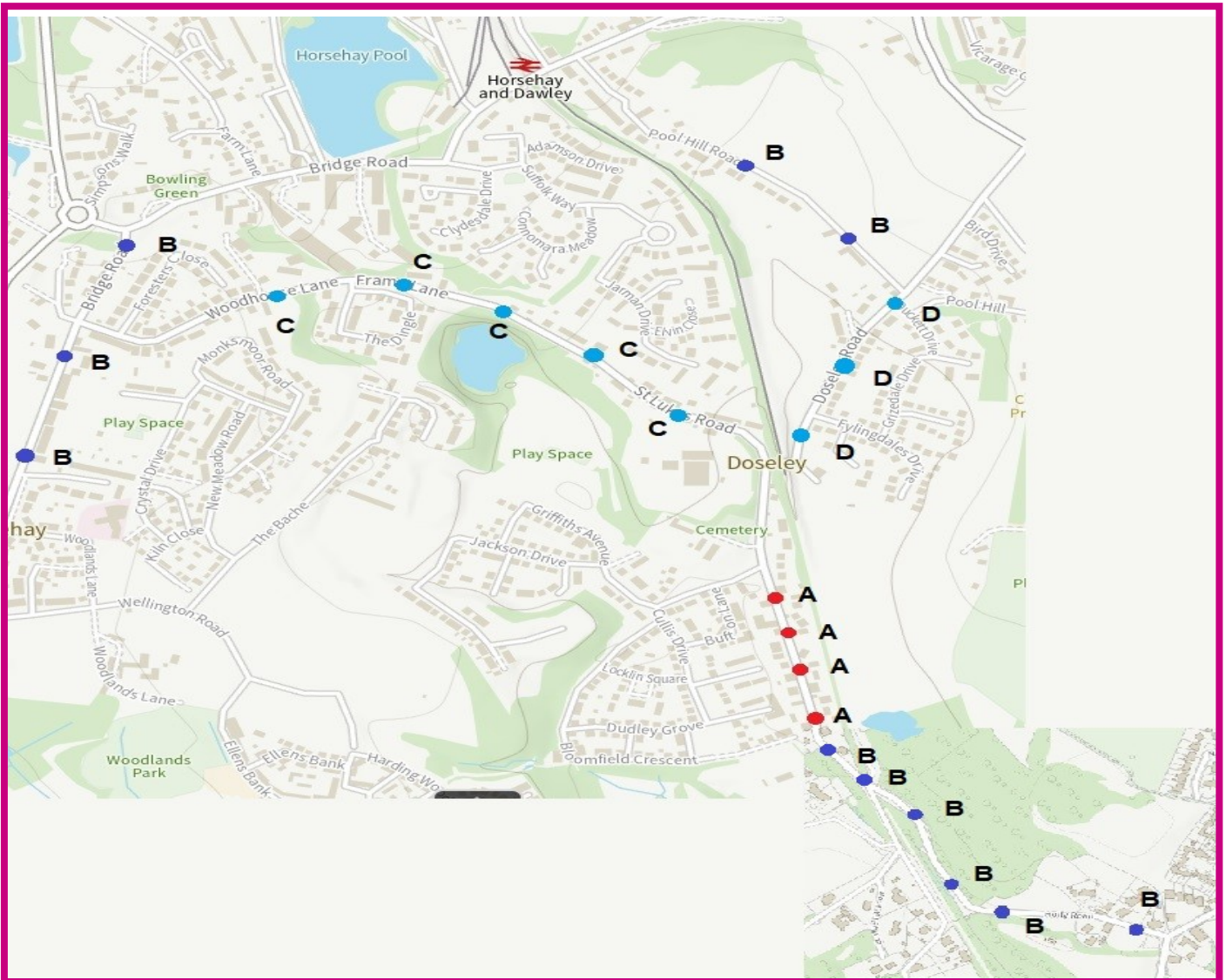

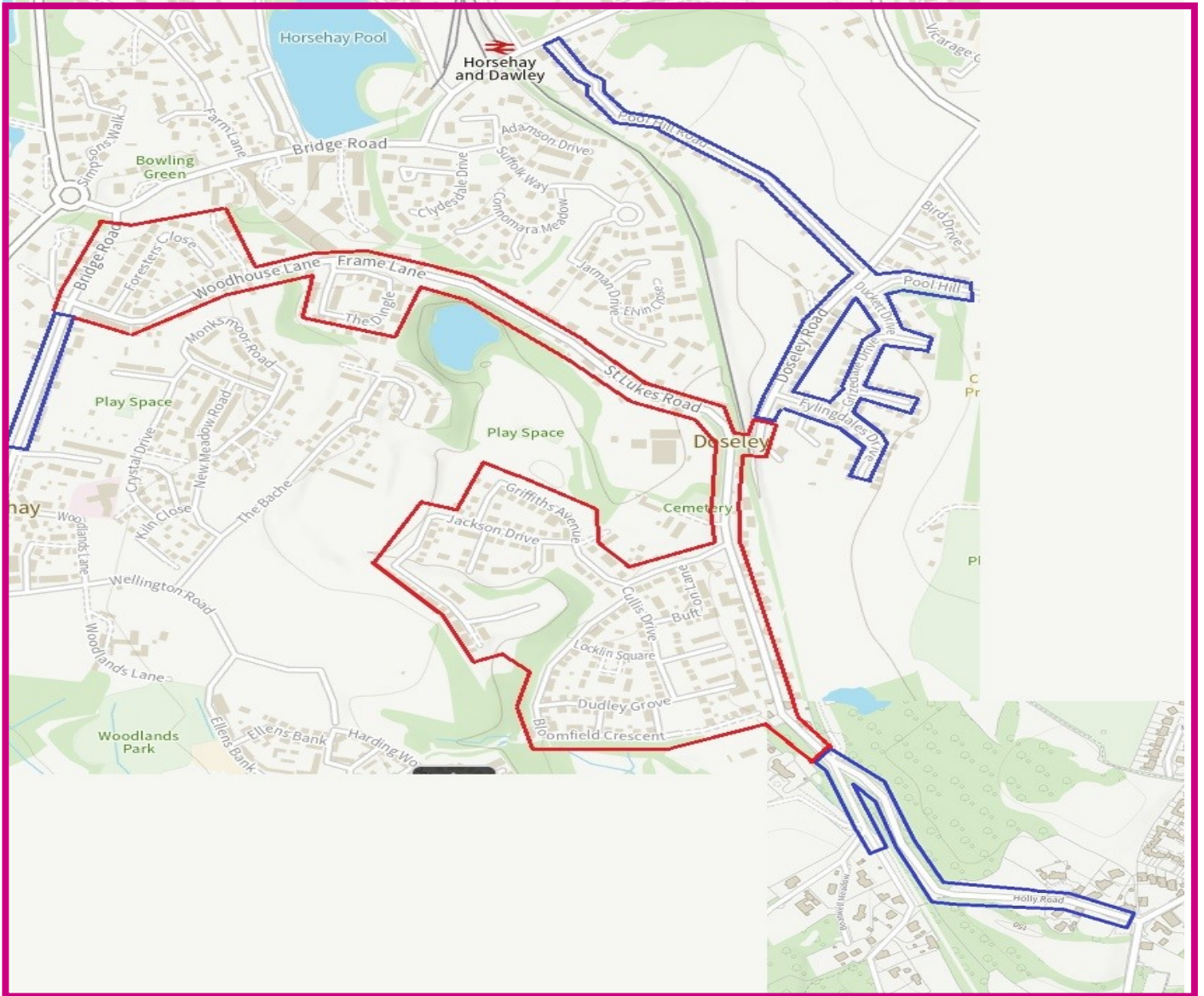
