SPRING IS COMING TO DAWLEY HAMLETS LOCAL NATURE RESERVE (LNR)

Spring is coming to the Local Nature Reserve and the Friends group hope you can get out and enjoy the fresh air with a walk around the Little Dawley Pools, down to the Southern end of the LNR to see Furnace Pools or up on The Mount by the Phoenix Fields to see the magnificent view across Telford. Try to look out for string like toad spawn lurking in the pools, scarlet elf cups, Brimstone butterflies and slow worms.

Work continues on the LNR and we're pleased to see developments ongoing and planned to the small pool off the Ironbridge Way and Furnace Pools and also look forward to the installation of a bench on The Mount by the Phoenix Fields. Thanks also to the Telford Angling Association for their recent work clearing Castle Pool and The Dandy.

We have some exciting events on the horizon this Spring and Summer. Look out for our first pond dipping event led by our very own volunteer ecologist Dr John Wilkinson. This has been made possible with a grant from Idverde for the equipment. We then look forward to our annual family summer event, thanks to a grant from Telford and Wrekin Council, which this year will be to be to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee; Save the date Saturday 16th July! TELFORD STEAM RAILWAY

The Telford Steam Railway organised The Polar Express Train Ride again in November and December last year. It was a great success attracting over 20,000 passengers from throughout Telford and many other parts of the country. The whole event is organised by the volunteers of the Telford Steam Railway, with all proceeds going into the development of the railway. Plans are already being made for Polar Express 2022.

Another massive event at the railway in November 2021, was that our own locomotive 5619 returned home and was the main locomotive pulling the Polar Express trains. 5619 was bought for the railway by Telford Development Corporation back in 1973, from the Barry scrapyard. After many hours of volunteers working on its restoration in the Horsehay loco shed, it was back and working in steam by 1981. It has been hired out to other railways and last steamed at Horsehay in 2008, before its return in November.



Lots of maintenance work currently is going on and the railway will be re-opening to the public with an Easter Gala on Sunday 17th April and Monday 18th April. We will then be operating on Sundays, Bank Holidays and selected other days from Easter to the end of September.



A memorial picture dedicated to the memory of our good friend and colleague, Cllr. Beryl Onions, is now proudly on display in Horsehay Village Hall.
